the objective is to express HOPE using the metaphor of a seed the order of creating them follows the order of the rising of the sun over the continents

the symbols of hope will be erected in environments where hope is much nedeed:



1. a hospital

to bring hope to people who are sick
title of the sculpture: illseed
continent: australasia - the frst continent where
the sun rises (new zealand)
project:

a vigorous sculpture, 7m. high, that expresses hope and is set at the entrance of a hospital a plaque with a message of encouragement will be placed nearby

* this frst objective is accomplished! dedicated on august 12th, 2007, the sculpture is welcoming visitors at the entrance of the north shore hospital, auckland, new zealand. (the sculpture is presented in the second part of this brochure)



3. a cemetery

to strengthen faith in eternal life

title of the sculpture: deadseed

continent: africa - the third continent
where the sun rises

project:
a seed sculpture, 7m high, emerging from a pyramid
base, placed in a cemetery


2. an orphanage


to bring joy to orphans


title of the sculpture: orphanseed **continent**: asia - the second continent where the sun rises

a playground (7 x 7 metres length) with forms inspired by seeds, placed on geometrical shapes, that children can play on children from that community would be involved in the creative process








testament


5. a prison

placing the seed at hospital



the cloak of winter binds and holds the **seed** tightly in its cold coccoon until the warm spring rains and the radiating heat of the sun kindly loosens the grip of winter. like spring fowers we peep out of our shelter, watching and waiting for this moment a time to stretch and explore a time to break free a time of hope

art in a hospital setting reminds patients and staf of their links with the outside community it assists them in retaining a sense of identity and control when they are faced with personal crisis, illness and fears, as well as helping them celebrate new beginnings and success


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
